## STUDENT SELECTION CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION INTO THE NURSING PROGRAM

Students applying to the OSU-Okmulgee Nursing Program are selected on the basis of a point system. Points are awarded for a score on the reading and math portion of the COMPASS Exam, completion of support courses with a “C” or better, OSU-Okmulgee course work only, and GPA. The specific points awarded are shown below.
