The visitors learned enough about OSU-Okmulgee students to extend an invitation to be the first in a student and faculty exchange program between their universities and ours. Morris business major Cody Jolliff acted as driver for the group as they toured the various academic divisions on campus. Presidents from the two universities signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with OSU-Okmulgee President Bob Klabenes. The MOU outlined terms of student and faculty exchanges. The visitors then extended an invitation to Jolliff to be the first student to participate.
