

OSUIT Presidents' Roundtable Minutes
November 5, 2008

Meeting called to order at 11:50 a.m.

Bruce Force welcomed the new attendees to the Presidents' Roundtable and asked them to introduce themselves: James Huddleson, Helen Orcutt, Scott Wolf, Junior Henry, Dr. Avant, Brian Coldwell, and Jessica Dear.

Bruce then relayed some announcements. He asked how everyone thought Carnifall was and asked if there was anyway to improve it for next year. The comments were made that the lighting was better this year and the suggestion that there be more space between tents and maybe to move the smoker down wind. Bruce Force then talked about the possibility of him making a sheet for everyone who is participating in Carnifall to write down whether they need electricity, more lighting, how many tents, etc. Beverly then spoke up and asked who all needed food handlers permits. TJ Stryker then asked if anyone from the clubs could come to the banquet. Bruce then replied that it depended on the location. Art Visconti mentioned having it in Covelle Hall, but Bruce said probably not because of catering, he said that they would probably have it in the student union or maybe the state room.

Bruce also mentioned that he's looking for things for the students to do on weekends and said that he'd be willing to sponsor or help sponsor and broadcast and help market the events. Art Visconti mentioned sand volleyball and maybe taking the winners to Tulsa to compete against other teams. Bruce also said that he would like to take the students that are here on the weekends to the Philbrook Museum, and the Air and Space Museum, and

maybe offer more classes like CPR. Then it was mentioned that people needed more notice about classes that were being offered like the CPR classes.

Mary Bell asked if anyone knew of a retailer that would give a group discount on toys and if so to let her know, and went on to ask what clubs did last year at the Christmas party and if anyone knew of anything new or fun that they would like to do. She also discussed the picture fiasco that happened last year, and then discussed ways to fix it. She also mentioned bringing a piece of heavy machinery over and decorating it for the children that don't want to have their picture taken with Santa.

NASA: Announced that it is Native American Month and that Nov. 13th is heritage day. Princess/Warrior pageant is Friday at 4 with treats. They will also be selling Indian tacos as a fundraiser, \$5 a taco, drinks and desert.

AITP: Went to the regional Competition in St. Angelo, they had one team make it to the finals and they also brought home an honorable mention. They also will be helping with the dance and the Children's Christmas party.
