Employment Rates for OSUIT Summer 2017-Spring 2018

Executive Summary

For OSU Institute of Technology, employment data continues to be difficult to obtain. Every term, an attempt is made to gather employment data from the graduating students on the Graduation Survey which is collected online with the help of the academic schools. While some students complete the Graduation Survey, some choose to fill in minimal information, and some choose not to submit the survey. Additionally, graduates are sent several emails requesting participation in the annual Alumni Survey and to complete the Employment Update form available on the OSUIT Institutional Research webpage. The Alumni Survey is sent to graduates 8 to 16 months post-graduation and participation is optional. The Alumni Survey employment data as well as the Employment Update data are incorporated into this report. In an effort to collect more data, Institutional Research employees check the LinkedIn website for employment data on those who did not submit data.

Since there continues to be a lack of usable data, the academic schools are asked to provide employment information on their graduates. Many faculty and staff members of the academic schools have kept in touch with their graduates, so this information is readily available. If the school does not have this information, they are asked to contact the graduate for the information. The data tables following this summary are based on data collected from the schools, Graduation Surveys, the follow-up Alumni Survey, and LinkedIn. If updated employment information was not provided by the Alumni Survey, online Employment Update or schools, the completed Graduation Survey was then used. This employment information is strictly based on employment and no other factors such as continuing education or military service.

There were 654 degrees awarded for summer 2017, fall 2017 and spring 2018 to 609 graduates. Of those 609 graduates, 384 (63%) submitted employment information. Of the 384 graduates who submitted information, 353 (92%) were employed full-time. Of the same 384 graduates, 331 (86%) were employed full-time in their major field.

If we look at the technical schools only, we find that there were 539 graduates. Sixty-nine percent (371) of theses graduates provided employment information. Of these 371 graduates, 92% (342) were employed full-time. Of the same 371 graduates, 87% (321) were employed full-time in field.

Another way to look at our graduates is to focus on the AAS and BT completers only. There were 539 graduates who received an AAS or BT degree during this time period. Of the 539, 371 (69%) submitted employment information. While 92% (343) of the 371 graduates were employed full-time, 87% (322) of the 371 graduates were employed full-time in their major field.

The average salary for the full-time in major field graduates increased slightly to the range of \$45,000-\$49,999 regardless of breakdown. Pay for graduates employed full-time in field started in the range of \$15,000-\$19,999 and the highest pay range was reported as \$100,000 and above.

Given the results of the various ways to breakdown our available employment data, we can definitely say that of our AAS or BT graduates who supplied employment information, 92% reported themselves as employed full-time and 87% reported as employed full-time in their major field area.
